

Acreage Reporting (ARD)

Accurate acreage reporting ensures that all planted crops are correctly covered under your policy.

Key requirements include:

- Reporting all planted crops to both the FSA and your crop insurance provider by the applicable Acreage Reporting Date (ARD).
- Providing an FSA-578 form to your agent, which reports acres using the appropriate Common Land Units (CLUs). This is the most efficient way to report your acreage.
- Reporting all insured acres, including prevented planting (PP) acres, replant acres, and uninsurable acres.
- Submitting planting dates for each crop.
- For perennial crops such as orchards and groves, signing a Pre-Acceptance Worksheet (PAW) by the ARD to certify your crop's status.
- Ensuring all paperwork is properly signed and submitted by the ARD deadline.

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
